BOY HURT BY ELECTRIC POLE HAS 50PC CHANCE OF SURVIVAL

Mum seeks prayers for son fighting for his life in the ICU

AN Aliff Danish Abdullah, 11, who is one of the three victims in the electric pole mishap here, is fighting for his life at Sultanah Bahiyah Hospital's Intensive Care Unit.
His mother, businesswoman Nur Zuraidah Zaimon, 29, said doctors told her Wan Aliff had a 50 per cent chance of survival.
She said doctors told her his lungs were still functioning although he was still unconscious.
Wan Aliff is the eldest child of three siblings.
"Doctors have managed to keep his lungs working. But they told me he is still fighting for his life and has a 50 per cent chance of survival," she told reporters at her home in Kampung Belukar, Jalan Kampung Darat, here, yesterday. She asked for people to pray for her son's recovery.
"Please pray for him, I really appreciate all the help my family can get," she said as tears streamed down her face.
She said she would accompany her son at the hospital with her husband, Wan Mohd Naim Wan Fadzilah, 30, her son, Wan Akhil Darus, 8, and her daughter, Wan Aira Batrisyia, 4.
