Their efforts had finally yielded results, she said. Meanwhile, Perhilitan Kelantan director Mohamad Hafid Rohani said the operation to catch the bear started on Aug 14 by setting traps near a school but this was moved to the back of the residents' houses on Oct 5 where repeated complaints were centred on. "It is understood that there are

two more (sun bears) in this area and I caution the villagers not to approach these (unpredictable) wild animals," he said.
